
Bog pine root

Ancient tree roots, some of them thousands of years old, sometimes emerge from the peat. They show how places that are now moorland were once forest: the pattern naturally shifts over time, as different farming methods, fires and climate change shape the landscape.



Patches of wet heathland and bogs dot the moorland. They're wonderful places for insects, which are a rich food source for birds.
